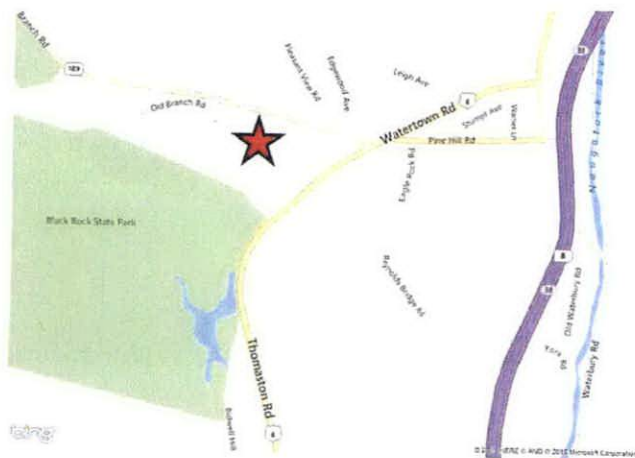

## Directions to Collection Site

**From Points North:** Take Route 8 South to Exit 38. At the end of the ramp, continue straight through the stop light (Route 6 West). Approx. 1/4 mile ahead on the right, bear right onto Rt. 109 West (before the next stop light). The high school will be on your left.

**From Points West:** Take Route 6 East toward Thomaston. Turn left on Route 109 West. The high school will be on your left.

**From Points South:** Take Route 8 North to Exit 38. At the end of the ramp turn left, going under the highway to the first stop light. Turn left at the light onto Pine Hill Rd. At the end of the road, turn left onto Route 6 West. Immediately bear right onto Route 109 West (before the stop light). The high school will be ahead on your left.

## Household Hazardous Waste

### What to Bring:

Mercury and Mercury thermometers, Drain & Oven Cleaners, Upholstery Cleaners, Poisons, Insecticides, Wood Cleaners, Aerosols, Metal Polishers, Pool & Photo Chemicals, Automotive Cleaners & Fluids, Grease & Rust Solvents, Alkaline Batteries, and Fluorescent Bulbs.

### What NOT to Bring:

**No** Auto Batteries, **No** Motor Oil, **No** Radioactive or Medical Waste, **No** Asbestos, **No** Explosives, and **No** Empty Fire Extinguishers, **No** Compressed Gas Cylinders, **No** Lead Paint Chips.

Limit of **50 lbs.** of waste per vehicle. Commercial and industrial waste will only be accepted through prior arrangement. Small quantity generators (CESQGs) please contact NVCOG if interested in participating in HHW collection.

## Paint Collection

Beginning July 1, 2013, Connecticut instituted a statewide paint recycling program known as PaintCare. PaintCare provides free recycling of architectural paint by placing a small fee on newly purchased paint. Acceptable paints will be collected at HHW events.

### Acceptable Paints:

Interior and exterior architectural paints, latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd, oil-based, enamel, deck coatings, floor paints, primers, sealers, undercoatings, field and lawn paints stains, shellacs, lacquers, varnishes, urethanes (single component), waterproofing sealers (except tar or bitumen based), metal coatings, rust preservatives.

Containers **larger** than **5** gallons will **not** be accepted.
