Introduction.

Since its inception in 1967, the Torrington Area Health District has been charged with enforcement of the Connecticut Public Health Code as amended over the years for its member towns. During that time, the TAHD has found it necessary to adopt rules, regulations and policies to promote public health in addition to the Ct. Public Health Code. This document is a compilation of those rules and regulations and is meant as a reference for use by the TAHD staff and the public. Cited below is the statutory authority granted to health district boards of health to adopt and amend regulations

Sec. 19a-243. (Formerly Sec. 19-108). District rules and regulations. Powers of district.

Meetings. Expenses. (a) Each board may make and adopt reasonable rules and regulations for the promotion of general health within the district not in conflict with law or with the general statutes or regulations of Connecticut state agencies.

At the discretion of the TAHD Board of Health, this document may from time to time be amended or revised in accordance with State Law.
